

## CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS FOR BAUBOX CABINETRY

- General Care** Soak a cloth in lukewarm water that is mixed with a small amount of pH-neutral detergent. After wiping cabinetry with this cloth, wipe again with a dry cloth.
- Avoid using chemical, polish or oil treatments as these can reduce the luster and shine of the lacquered surface and/or leave marks.
- Lacquer** Surface can be cleaned with a soft cloth or sponge and a normal household cleaning agent with water. Always remember to remove moisture residue by rubbing dry.
- High Gloss Lacquer** Surface can be cleaned with a soft cloth or sponge and a normal household cleaning agent with water. Always remember to remove moisture residue by rubbing dry.
- Laminate** Surface can be cleaned with a soft cloth or sponge and a normal household cleaning agent with water. Always remember to remove moisture residue by rubbing dry.
- Interior** Surface can be cleaned with a soft cloth or sponge and a normal household cleaning agent with water. Always remember to remove moisture residue by rubbing dry.
- Aluminum** Aluminum surfaces are sensitive to scratches, alkali and acids. For cleaning, use a soft sponge-type cloth and a few drops of washing liquid in warm water.
- Heavily soiled aluminum should be cleaned with a soft fluff-free, micro fiber cloth. Wipe horizontally, without applying pressure to the surfaces. Do not use aggressive cleaners, or stainless steel cleaning agents. Sponges will scratch the surface.

## CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS FOR BAUBOX CABINETRY

- Fittings** To ensure that the high-quality fittings (hinges) function correctly for many years, the joints should be oiled occasionally with a non-resin, high-quality oil.
- Stainless Steel** Surface can be cleaned with a soft cloth or sponge and a normal household cleaning agent with water. Always remember to remove moisture residue by rubbing dry.
- Always apply in the direction of sanding. Do not use sharp or abrasive cleaning agents, which may cause areas to appear matte.
- If heavy grease is present, use a de-greasing agent first, then follow steps above.
- Engineered Stone** Surface can be cleaned with a soft cloth or sponge and a normal household cleaning agent with water. Always remember to remove moisture residue by rubbing dry.
- Natural Stone** Surface can be cleaned with a soft cloth or sponge and a normal household cleaning agent with water. General dirt and grease should be removed by using a mild soap and warm water. Always remember to remove moisture residue by rubbing dry.
- Warning** Abrasive cleaning agents should not be used. Nitro-based cleaning agents, artificial resin and thinners should not be used for cleaning surfaces.
- Furniture polishes can contain unsuitable additives. Observe the instructions of the respective cleaning agent manufacturers.
